## **Overview**

Hort Innovation convened a meeting of the prune Strategic Investment Advisory Panel (SIAP) on September 13, 2016.

Hort Innovation provided an induction for panel members outlining the objectives, governance and scope of operation of the panel. An overview of the Hort Innovation funding model, innovation process and procurement framework was also provided.

The panel also discussed:

- > The forecast for levy income for the current year and future years
- Opportunities for alternative sources of funds to contribute to the objectives of the industry
- The industry's short term investment priorities including: extension and technical advice; pollination; and international networking

Prior to the SIAP meeting, the panel also participated in an independently facilitated strategic planning workshop together with other interested growers. The workshop built upon the feedback received from growers through a short survey and through direct discussions with growers at the Australian Prune Industry Association conference on September 12, 2016.
